Environmental Development Permit Exemptions Section (9.6.6.3): In instances where an ESA had been previously identified on maps, but is no longer present, the City will take into account whether the ESA is no longer present due to its destruction. Where destruction in the form of land clearing, drainage or any alteration that affected the ESA is known to have occurred, the City will require that an EDP be registered on title to include ecological restoration provisions;

Environmental Development Permit Guidelines Section (9.6.6.4): A phased clearing approach may be required on large developments that are expected to be developed over a number of years. The specifics of this condition will depend on the nature of the development, its servicing requirements, environmental and neighbourhood aesthetic considerations;

Environmental Development Permit Guidelines Section (9.6.6.4), describing what may be required as part of the Environmental Impact Assessment: Habitat connectivity opportunities within the property and to adjacent properties, including connectivity of native vegetation and trees;

Environmental Development Permit Guidelines Section (9.6.6.4), describing what may be required as part of the Environmental Impact Assessment: Location of site accesses shall be included in the Plan;

Environmental Development Permit Guidelines Section (9.6.6.4) in describing what may be required as part of the Tree Inventory and Assessment (new wording in italics): A plan for connectivity of leavestrips and natural area may be required and may be required to be coordinated with the Registered Professional Biologist;

The following definition has been added to the Environmental Development Permit Definitions Section (9.6.6.5): Non-disturbance area: includes the areas where no development activities are to take place unless as permitted by the Director Development Services, and in

consultation with environmental consultants; and

That the Arden Corridor Local Area Plan Amendment, Bylaw No. 2756, proceed to third reading as amended and final adoption. **Carried**
