6TH ST. PEDESTRIAN CYCLING BRIDGE

WHEREAS a professional engineering study conducted by the City provided valuable information regarding the potential construction of a pedestrian/cycling bridge over the Courtenay River at the bottom of 6^{th} Street; and

WHEREAS a subsequent design evaluation process conducted by the Courtenay River Pedestrian/Cycling Bridge Steering Committee recommended a clear span, low maintenance, low environmental impact design, as outlined in the Design Brief circulated to Council and Staff in December 2014 and presented by delegation on April 13th; and

WHEREAS the Courtenay River Pedestrian/Cycling Bridge Steering Committee proposes to raise all required funds to finance the construction of such a bridge; and

WHEREAS such a bridge would be a significant transportation, recreation and tourism asset to the City, facilitating a river crossing for pedestrians and cyclists that extents the existing Riverway trail system and helps link downtown to Simms and Lewis Parks;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Council re-affirms support in principle for this project and requests Staff to work with the Bridge Steering Committee to develop a Memorandum of Understanding to facilitate the project.
