

# Construction Notice



## Duncan Avenue from 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 6<sup>th</sup> Street Watermain Replacement Project

The City of Courtenay has awarded the Duncan Avenue watermain replacement project to Windley Contracting Ltd. Construction is scheduled to begin starting either the week of September 6<sup>th</sup> or September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 with a planned completion date in late October.

**Once the construction start date has been confirmed, the contractor will update you.**

Vehicle traffic and on-street parking will be restricted within the work area. There will also be intermittent disruptions to your water service. Windley will work with businesses to accommodate any access or construction related matters and will make every attempt to notify owners in advance of access matters affecting individual businesses. Pedestrian access will be maintained to all businesses throughout construction and a minimum of 48 hours notice will be given before any planned water shut-offs.

Traffic Control Personnel will be on site to direct vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists within the work area.
