

Commercial Toilet Rebate Program

The City of Courtenay wants to help commercial building owners be more efficient with water use and to reduce water consumption, which lowers demand for water and lessens wasted water. This, in turn, will keep future infrastructure costs down.

Replacing a 13 litre (L) toilet with a dual flush (usually three and six L) or high-efficiency (4.8 L) toilet would reduce indoor water use by approximately 18 percent. Homes with older 20 L flush toilets would experience even larger reductions.

As of November 1, 2010, there is no limit on the number of toilets per installation address eligible for the rebate. The program has a budget of approximately \$33,750. This program is offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

Commercial property owners who replace old, water guzzling toilets in their buildings built prior to December 15, 2006 will be eligible for a \$100 rebate to install a high-efficiency (4.8 Litre flush) or Dual Flush CSA (Canadian Standards Association) approved toilets.

Rebates are also available to replace old 5.7 Litre flush urinals (or greater) with high efficiency 1.9 Litre urinals.

The rebate program only applies to City of Courtenay commercial property owners connected to the Comox Valley Water System.

The rebate application form is on the other side of this brochure. It is also available for pick-up at City Hall (upstairs Engineering Division) or online at www.courtenay.ca

Completed applications, along with receipts dated June 1, 2010 or later, should be dropped off at City Hall (upstairs Engineering Division).

- Only high efficiency (4.8 Litre) and Dual Flush toilets or 1.9 Litre flush urinals are eligible.
- As of November 1, 2010, there is no limit on the number of toilets per installation address eligible for the rebate.

- Please Note: A limited number of rebates are available for the program. Rebates are only available to registered owners of commercial properties in the City of Courtenay connected to the Comox Valley water System. This excludes properties on private wells and those parts of the Sandwick Waterworks and Royston Water Local Service Area within the City of Courtenay.

Commercial Toilet Rebate Form

PLEASE READ THIS FIRST!

1. Eligibility: (for complete eligibility requirements, please visit www.courtenay.ca)

- Applicants must be registered owners of commercial units on properties within the City of Courtenay who are connected to the **Comox Valley water system**. Rebate cheques will be issued to registered owners only.
- NOTE: Commercial properties serviced by private wells or utilities, improvement districts (e.g. Sandwich water supply) **DO NOT QUALIFY** as they are not fed by the Comox Valley water system. The program is funded only by those connected to the Comox Valley water system.
- Must have replaced an old inefficient toilet that uses 13 L or more per flush (ensure flush volume, usually stamped on toilet) with one that is considered high-efficiency (4.8 L/flush) or Dual Flush and is CSA (Canadian Standards Association) approved. As of November 1, 2010, there is no limit on the number of toilets per installation address eligible for the rebate.
- Must have a sales receipt for a new high efficiency toilet dated June 1, 2010 or later.
- Must have a disposal receipt which can be obtained by disposing of your old toilet at the City of Courtenay Public Works Yard (1000 Piercy Avenue Courtenay, B.C). Commercial owners who retain the services of qualified plumbers can submit the new toilet receipt and the application form if they include a receipt from the plumber showing the plumber's name, company info, signature and technical qualification (TQ) number.

I declare: that I am a City of Courtenay commercial property owner and my property is connected to the Comox Valley water supply system; that I have removed a 13L (or larger) per flush toilet and installed a maximum 4.8L per flush toilet, OR a 5.7L (or larger) urinal and installed a 1.9L flush urinal. I understand that the City of Courtenay is not responsible for the installation or functioning of toilets. The City of Courtenay reserves the right to inspect or verify that the above items have been installed.

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The City of Courtenay will review submissions to verify eligibility and if you qualify, will mail you a rebate cheque. The submission of an application will not guarantee a rebate. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis while funding lasts.
