.02 SNOW & ICE CONTROL UPDATE FROM RECENT SNOWFALL EVENT JANUARY 15 - 17, 2020 5400-11 Trevor Kushner, Director of Public Works Services/Assistant CAO, provided a verbal report to Council of the Public Works Services department's response following the recent heavy snowfall event January 15th - 17th, 2020.

Mr. Kushner summarized the City's snow and ice control program and priority clearing response:

- 1. Arterial roads, emergency services facilities and bus routes
- 2. Collector roads, steep hills, school zones and downtown core commercial area
- 3. Local roads, cul-de-sacs and lanes on these routes residents should expect a single plow pass to accommodate emergency access for police, fire and ambulance

A discussion followed regarding challenges faced by crews associated with on-street parking in residential areas and cul-de-sacs; and how intensity, duration and timing of snowfall events can play a significant role in the City's response.
