Huntington Disease Awareness Month

WHEREAS Huntington Disease (HD) is a genetic brain disorder with

physical, mental and emotional symptoms which is often described as having ALS, Parkinson's, schizophrenia and

Alzheimer's, all at the same time; and

WHEREAS one in every 7,000 Canadians has HD and approximately one

in every 5,500 is at-risk for developing the disease; and

WHEREAS each child of a parent with Huntington disease has a 50%

chance of having the gene mutation that leads to the

progression of Huntington disease; and

WHEREAS there is no known cure; and

WHEREAS organizations working in Canada and around the world are

raising awareness and building hope by delivering support

services and supporting research;

NOW THEREFORE I, Bob Wells, Mayor of the City of Courtenay, do hereby

proclaim May, 2023, as HUNTINGTON DISEASE

AWARENESS MONTH in the City of Courtenay.
