heritage, traditions, languages, cultural practices, and spirituality of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples;

WHEREAS 2023 marks the 27th anniversary of the proclamation of

June 21st as a day to annually recognize and celebrate the diverse cultures of Indigenous Peoples in Canada;

NOW THEREFORE I, Bob Wells, Mayor of the City of Courtenay, do hereby

proclaim June 21st, 2023, as "National Indigenous

Peoples Day" in the City of Courtenay; and,
