3rd Street from Cliffe Avenue to England Avenue Street Reconstruction Project

A street reconstruction project is planned for your area this year. The work will take place at some point during this upcoming construction season. You will be notified again when construction dates have been confirmed.

This project includes replacement of all underground City utilities, repaving of road, narrowing the roadway width, new sidewalk on the south side (existing sidewalk on north side to be removed), rebuilding of the traffic circle at Duncan Ave and other surface improvements.

During construction, on-street parking and vehicle traffic will be limited at times and there will be intermittent disruptions to your water service. The contractor will work with residents to accommodate any property access related matters and will provide a minimum of 48 hours' notice before any planned water shut-offs.

Traffic Control Personnel will be on site to direct vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists within the work area.
