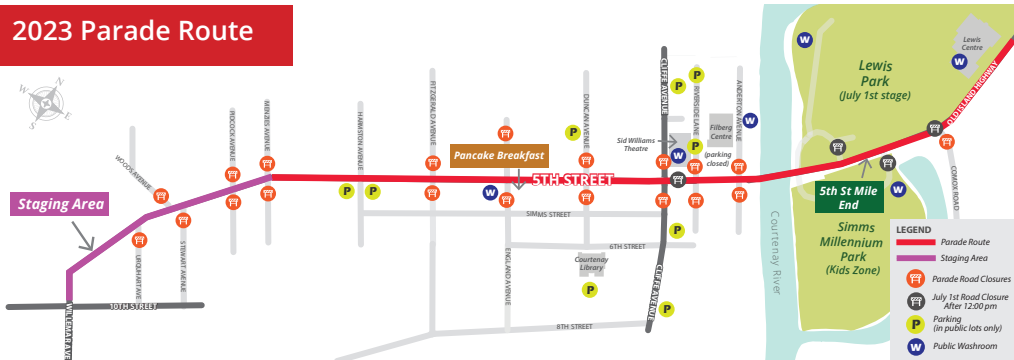


SAFETY REGULATIONS

1. **NOTHING IS TO BE THROWN FROM ANY PARADE ENTRY!** If gifts or goodies are given out, they must be delivered to spectators.
2. **NO SMOKING ON, NEAR OR DURING THE PARADE.**
3. Exhaust pipes must **NOT** be wrapped and not be near paper or decorations.
4. Proper driver vision and ventilation **is required.**
5. All vehicles to be in good mechanical condition.
6. All participants on entries **MUST** wear safety belts or have hand-holds or railings close by whilst float is moving.

All participants must be made aware that the City of Courtenay, sponsors, employees, associates, members and volunteers are not responsible for any damage or accidents that may occur prior to, during or after the event. The participant is responsible for ensuring they follow the guidelines set forth. Noncompliance of Guidelines and Safety Regulations may result in dismissal from participation of future parades.

This event is family and community oriented. Any entries of negative or controversial content will not be permitted and the City reserves the right to refuse any entries and pursue any legal charges as appropriate.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

ALL ENTRIES MUST:

- Maintain a **maximum spacing of 2 car lengths (40 feet)** of space from the entry in front of them and be able to maintain a speed of 3 km/h to 7 km/h.
- **MUST PROVIDE ONE PERSON TO WALK AS PACER PER ENTRY**
- Be 50% decorated except for those designated as antiques (License Plate)
- Carry a fire extinguisher in working order
- Drivers must remain with floats at all time
- Not deliberately impact the flow, theme or operation of the parade or event
- All motorized entries must be **licensed and insured** for use on roadways and carry minimum of **\$2 Million** in liability coverage and provide evidence **if requested**.
- Animal entries must carry necessary clean up equipment

PARADE REQUIREMENTS

- **ALL ENTRIES MUST ENTER STAGING AREA THROUGH CHECK IN STATION AT (9th STREET & WILLEMAR)**
- Entries must be in position at 9:45am – we will not be able to accommodate late arrival
- Walking entries must Park/Drop off at Lake Trail School
- Alcohol, drugs and any other incapacitating substances are forbidden
- Appropriate attire is required for all participants
- **50% of vehicle MUST be decorated**
- Forward motion must be maintained at all times – **STOPPING IS NOT PERMITTED**
- Courtenay Fire Department may conduct inspections of floats on the day to ensure all safety rules are followed
- Entrants are responsible for removing their entry immediately at the end of the route unless otherwise arranged
