To complete your LEAP membership we will need to take a photo of each individual on your application. Membership cards will only be issued to those 12+ that would like to use their LEAP membership for the Fitness Studio. All other users will be deducted manually at reception.

For those using the Fitness Studio, you will scan your membership card for each visit. All other drop-in's will be processed. We have a variety of drop-in programs for different age groups. Please inquire which programs are available.

When your application has been approved and processed, you will be notified by phone. Please indicate to the front desk staff where you wish to pick up your membership card (Sports Centre on Vanier Dr. or the Aquatic Centre on Lerwick Rd). If you applied at one of the partnered Municipal Recreation Centre's – you will be responsible for coming into the Sports or Aquatic Centre to pick up your LEAP scan card.

Each time you visit the Sports & Aquatic Centre for a drop-in swim, skate or weight room visit bring your CVRD scan card with you. Upon entry, it will be scanned and 1 free drop-in will be removed.

While we don't issue physical cards, your pass will be created in our system and ready to use immediately upon successful application at the Cumberland Recreation Centre. If you applied at a partnered recreation centre in Courtenay, Comox or the CVRD, your file will be held until you contact us to activate your pass.

Simply identify yourself when you arrive to use the Fitness Studio or attend an eligible program and our staff will ensure your visit is applied to your account.

Your LEAP pass is valid for the Fitness Studio, squash courts and all Drop-In Programs, such as pickleball, open climbing, table tennis and more. Drop-In Programs are subject to change, so for a complete list please refer to the current Comox Valley Recreation Guide.

Courtenay Recreation Recreation Access Program (RAP)

Eligibility:

- Proof of residency within the City of Courtenay boundaries (current address on ID, utility bill or other official documentation)
- BCID/BC Services cards for each family member
- Current family income is within Statistics Canada Low Income Measure (LIM)
- Completed and signed application

Eligible residents will receive:

- Adults: \$350 scholarship amount to be used to discount programs and services
- Youth: \$400 scholarship amount to be used to discount programs and services
- Children: \$450 scholarship amount to be used to discount programs and services

Comox Recreation **Inclusion Program** (TRIP)

Eligibility:

- · Proof of residency within the Town of Comox (current address on ID AND a utility bill or rent receipt)
- BCID/BC Services cards for each family member
- Current family income is within Statistics Canada Low Income Measure (LIM)
- Completed and signed application

Eligible residents will receive:

Qualified applicants receive \$425/per year towards 50% discount on programs and Fitness Studio memberships. Contract programs are not included unless otherwise determined by the contractor. Post-secondary students are not eligible. TRIP expiry December 31 of each year and are only valid for the applicant it was assigned to. Each member of the family is eligible for TRIP. A family consists of parents or guardians and children. Contact the Community Centre for more information.

- 52 free admissions per calendar year for each family member to drop-in programs/services/activities at CVRD recreation facilities.
- LEAP participants also receive a \$350 subsidy per family member that can be used towards the cost of registered CVRD recreation programs at the CVRD Sports and Aquatic Centres.

Cumberland Recreation Financial Assitance in Recreation (FAIR)
