Notice of Application

City of Courtenay hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, City of Courtenay has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 11094 or, under the NPP File Number 2021-505401 a description of the following work, its site and plans: construction of active transportation bridge in, on, over, under, through or across Courtenay River at Courtenay, BC in front of lot number at the foot of 6th Street connecting to Simms Park.
