A friendly reminder to families: to help keep everyone healthy, please keep your child home if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- **An underarm temperature:** of 100 degrees F (37.8 degrees C) or higher, or an oral/ear temperature of 101 degrees F (38.3 degrees C) or higher; Underarm temperature has remained below 100 degrees F for twenty-four hours without medication.
- **Diarrhea:** The child must not attend until he/she has had twenty-four hours since the last episode or has been examined by a doctor and received written medical clearance.
- **Vomiting:** The child must not attend the preschool until twenty-four hours have passed since last bout of vomiting and no other signs of illness is present.
- **Acute cold or flu-like symptoms with coughing, atypical running, coloured discharge from nose or eyes and/or sore throat:** Symptoms have subsided and/or child has been examined by a doctor and has received written medical clearance.
- **Has been on antibiotics for less than twenty-four hours:** After a minimum of twenty-four hours has passed, depending on the condition
- **Skin infection, undiagnosed rash, eye infection, or any signs of contagious disease:** Child has been examined by a doctor or public health nurse and has been properly treated and has received written medical clearance.
- **Any parasite-related condition (such as scabies):** Children who are unwell may not participate in the preschool programs.

We appreciate your support in helping prevent the spread of illness and keeping our preschool well.
